
- Detailed schedule will be distributed later in April

 - Steve (WA8EIH) notifies Washington County Sheriff of event
- Friday (May 2nd) Venue open 5-8 PM (indoor); 5 PM-overnight (outdoor); Sunset 8:08 PM.
 - ARA starts venue setup 5:00 PM
 - About 5:00 PM Ted (KA3EGV) arrives & sets up RV to monitor venue & provide assistance for evening/overnight arrivals
 - Food truck shows at 6 PM Friday confirmed
 - Indoor Vendors set up 6-8 PM. Outdoor vendors set up anytime after 6 PM (at own risk)
 - ARA Members drop off equipment for sale on club table 6-8 PM
 - Indoor facility locked at 8 PM but access available if needed (Ted has key If RV Porch Light on, knock on door)
